



Cromarty Harbour Trust Safeguarding Statement

Organisations that work with children and vulnerable groups have legal and regulatory responsibilities in relation to safeguarding, but keeping people safe is an essential part of any voluntary sector organisation's governance framework. Any of the above category of organisations, and sometime within organisations, requires a Basic Disclosure Scotland Check which is a certificate highlighting any Unspent Convictions on an individuals' criminal record.

As an organisation Cromarty Harbour Trust does not work directly with children and vulnerable groups, but organisations that use the harbour may do. In which case we require that evidence should be provided with evidence that they have the relevant certification.
